Eligibility

The exhibition is open to all artists 18 years of age or older. Work must be original, created within two years of entry date, and not previously have won an award in a juried exhibition. **NO CLASS WORK WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

The art exhibition has been designed for the community at large including families and children; therefore, frontal nudity, overt sexual acts, or intentional gore or violence will not be allowed in the works of art selected for the exhibition.

Media

Oils, acrylic, pastel, watercolor, colored pencil, and mixed media are acceptable. Photographs, computer generated art, sculpture or other 3D works, crafts etc. will not be accepted.

Specifications

All artwork must be dry and wired for hanging. Sturdy screw eyes must be used with twisted safety wire that is securely attached for hanging 1/3rd of the distance down from the top of frame. Artwork (including frame) must not exceed 30" X 40". Glass will not be accepted in any framed artwork with dimensions exceeding 24" X 30". Minimum size of framed work is 11" x 14". Any artwork considered unsafe for gallery display will not be accepted. All artwork must be labeled on the back with title of artwork, artist name, medium, and sale price.

Entry Requirements

Entries must be hand delivered to The Bonita Museum located at 4355 Bonita Road on Oct 6. An entry fee of \$10 for each painting will be collected on October 6, a maximum of two paintings per artist is allowed.

Unaccepted Entries

Return to The Bonita Museum at 12:00 p.m. Oct. 6 to determine if your artwork has been accepted for exhibition. All unaccepted art must be picked up at that time.

Accepted Entries

Accepted entries will be installed at the Bonita Museum Oct. 6 - Nov. 14 and must not be removed until the last day of the show.

Opening Reception

A reception for artists and their guests will be held at the Bonita Museum on Saturday, Oct. 24, 5:30 - 7:30 p.m. Awards will be announced and presented during the reception.

Art Sales

Sale of artwork is encouraged. No commission is charged, however, a donation to the Bonita Museum and Cultural Center of 10% of sale price is encouraged.

Liability

The Chula Vista Art Guild (CVAG) and the Bonita Museum are not responsible for damage, theft, or loss to artwork. Works of art received are subject to these conditions. Insurance is the responsibility of individual artists.
