Membership

Active Members:* Annual dues is \$40. Active Members are considered working artists. Only Active Members can submit paintings into the Annual Members' Show. Active members attend monthly general meetings; submit artwork into Guild sponsored art competitions, exhibitions, and website; vote in elections; and serve on committees.

Associate Members:* Annual dues is \$20. Associate Members are considered supporters of the arts. Associate Members attend monthly general meetings and serve on committees but may not show artwork, vote, or hold office.

*Member Selection

New Active and Associate Members shall be selected by an anonymous jury composed of three Active Members and by secret vote. An applicant shall attend three general meetings and on the third meeting submit their application and initial dues.

In addition to attending three general meetings, an Active Member applicant must submit three (3) original paintings in any medium to be juried by CVAG officers. No applicant shall submit copies to be juried.

<u>Life Members:</u> Life Members are Active Members who have been appointed by the Board of Directors for their continued and selfless service to the Guild. They are voting members and may pay dues, but, are not required to pay dues.

Honorary Members: Honorary Members are interested parties from the community who have been appointed by the Board of Directors. They do not have voting rights and do not pay dues.

All membership categories receive the monthly newsletter by e-mail or postal service.

Note: The descriptions of Active and Associate Memberships are generalized. By-Laws of the Chula Vista Art Guild Inc. adopted in 2015 provide detailed requirements and procedures for acceptance of all membership categories.

Original Artwork Statement

All Artists entering artwork into a Chula Vista Art Guild sponsored art show, exhibition, , competition, display (<u>including submittal for membership</u>), and for inclusion on the Guild's internet website is required to sign a statement attesting the art being entered is their original artwork created by them in compliance with the U.S. Copyright Law before the artwork will be accepted.

[The following excerpts from Circular 40 issued by the U.S. Copyright Office are provided for your information.)

Copyright is a form of protection provided by U.S. law to authors of "original works of authorship," including "pictorial, graphic, and sculptural works." The owner of copyright in a work has the exclusive right to make copies, prepare derivative works, sell or distribute copies, and display the work publicly. Anyone else wishing to use the work in these ways must have the permission of the author or someone who has derived rights through the author.

A work is automatically protected by copyright when it is created, that is, "fixed" in a copy or phonorecord for the first time. Neither registration in the Copyright Office nor publication is required for copyright protection.]
